PROFILE

Disciplinary Inquiries have been an obvious spin-off from this work.

Terence's experience of prosecuting and defending serious crime in the first ten years or so of his practice developed his well recognised advocacy skills and make Health and Safety prosecutions an obvious development from his personal injury work.

Terence has a particular interest in stress claims which fits well with his Employment Law practice.
